1 AN ACT Relating to courses of instruction on beer, wine, and
2 spirituous liquor; and amending RCW 66.28.150.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.28.150 and 2004 c 160 s 14 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 A domestic brewery, microbrewery, domestic winery, distillery,
7 distributor, certificate of approval holder, or its licensed agent or
8 a licensee or manager may, without charge, instruct licensees and their
9 employees, or conduct courses of instruction for licensees and their
10 employees, on the subject of beer, wine, or spirituous liquor,
11 including but not limited to, the history, nature, values, and
12 characteristics of beer, wine, or spirituous liquor, the use of wine
13 lists, and the methods of presenting, serving, storing, and handling
14 beer, wine, or spirituous liquor. The domestic brewery, microbrewery,
15 domestic winery, distillery, distributor, certificate of approval
16 holder, or its licensed agent or the licensee or manager may furnish
17 beer, wine, or spirituous liquor and such other equipment, materials,
18 and utensils as may be required for use in connection with the
19 instruction or courses of instruction. The instruction or courses of

1 instruction may be given at the premises of the domestic brewery,
2 microbrewery, domestic winery, distillery, or authorized representative
3 holding a certificate of approval, at the premises of a retail
4 licensee, or elsewhere within the state of Washington.

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
