- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.0131 and 1994 c 188 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:
- For the purposes of determining resident tuition rates, resident

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     Washington at least one year before enrollment, shall not be included
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in any calculation of state-funded enrollment for budgeting purposes,

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- 1 and no state general fund moneys shall be appropriated to a state
- 2 institution of higher education for the support of such student.

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
