- AN ACT Relating to the assault weapons ban of 2005; amending RCW 9.41.010 and 9.94A.515; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; adding a new section to chapter 9.41 RCW; prescribing penalties; providing an effective date; providing an expiration date; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 Sec. 1. RCW 9.41.010 and 2001 c 300 s 2 are each amended to read 8 as follows:
- 9 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter.
- 11 (1) "Firearm" means a weapon or device from which a projectile or 12 projectiles may be fired by an explosive such as gunpowder.
- 13 (2) "Pistol" means any firearm with a barrel less than sixteen 14 inches in length, or is designed to be held and fired by the use of a 15 single hand.
- 16 (3) "Rifle" means a weapon designed or redesigned, made or remade, 17 and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed or redesigned, 18 made or remade, and intended to use the energy of the explosive in a

fixed metallic cartridge to fire only a single projectile through a rifled bore for each single pull of the trigger.

- (4) "Short-barreled rifle" means a rifle having one or more barrels less than sixteen inches in length and any weapon made from a rifle by any means of modification if such modified weapon has an overall length of less than twenty-six inches.
- (5) "Shotgun" means a weapon with one or more barrels, designed or redesigned, made or remade, and intended to be fired from the shoulder and designed or redesigned, made or remade, and intended to use the energy of the explosive in a fixed shotgun shell to fire through a smooth bore either a number of ball shot or a single projectile for each single pull of the trigger.
- (6) "Short-barreled shotgun" means a shotgun having one or more barrels less than eighteen inches in length and any weapon made from a shotgun by any means of modification if such modified weapon has an overall length of less than twenty-six inches.
- (7) "Machine gun" means any firearm known as a machine gun, mechanical rifle, submachine gun, or any other mechanism or instrument not requiring that the trigger be pressed for each shot and having a reservoir clip, disc, drum, belt, or other separable mechanical device for storing, carrying, or supplying ammunition which can be loaded into the firearm, mechanism, or instrument, and fired therefrom at the rate of five or more shots per second.
- (8) "Antique firearm" means a firearm or replica of a firearm not designed or redesigned for using rim fire or conventional center fire ignition with fixed ammunition and manufactured in or before 1898, including any matchlock, flintlock, percussion cap, or similar type of ignition system and also any firearm using fixed ammunition manufactured in or before 1898, for which ammunition is no longer manufactured in the United States and is not readily available in the ordinary channels of commercial trade.
 - (9) "Loaded" means:

- (a) There is a cartridge in the chamber of the firearm;
- 34 (b) Cartridges are in a clip that is locked in place in the 35 firearm;
- 36 (c) There is a cartridge in the cylinder of the firearm, if the 37 firearm is a revolver;

- 1 (d) There is a cartridge in the tube or magazine that is inserted 2 in the action; or
 - (e) There is a ball in the barrel and the firearm is capped or primed if the firearm is a muzzle loader.
 - (10) "Dealer" means a person engaged in the business of selling firearms at wholesale or retail who has, or is required to have, a federal firearms license under 18 U.S.C. Sec. 923(a). A person who does not have, and is not required to have, a federal firearms license under 18 U.S.C. Sec. 923(a), is not a dealer if that person makes only occasional sales, exchanges, or purchases of firearms for the enhancement of a personal collection or for a hobby, or sells all or part of his or her personal collection of firearms.
 - (11) "Crime of violence" means:

- (a) Any of the following felonies, as now existing or hereafter amended: Any felony defined under any law as a class A felony or an attempt to commit a class A felony, criminal solicitation of or criminal conspiracy to commit a class A felony, manslaughter in the first degree, manslaughter in the second degree, indecent liberties if committed by forcible compulsion, kidnapping in the second degree, arson in the second degree, assault in the second degree, assault of a child in the second degree, extortion in the first degree, burglary in the second degree, residential burglary, and robbery in the second degree;
- (b) Any conviction for a felony offense in effect at any time prior to June 6, 1996, which is comparable to a felony classified as a crime of violence in (a) of this subsection; and
- (c) Any federal or out-of-state conviction for an offense comparable to a felony classified as a crime of violence under (a) or (b) of this subsection.
- (12) "Serious offense" means any of the following felonies or a felony attempt to commit any of the following felonies, as now existing or hereafter amended:
 - (a) Any crime of violence;
- 34 (b) Any felony violation of the uniform controlled substances act, 35 chapter 69.50 RCW, that is classified as a class B felony or that has 36 a maximum term of imprisonment of at least ten years;
 - (c) Child molestation in the second degree;
 - (d) Incest when committed against a child under age fourteen;

- (f) Leading organized crime;
- 3 (q) Promoting prostitution in the first degree;
 - (h) Rape in the third degree;
 - (i) Drive-by shooting;
- 6 (j) Sexual exploitation;
 - (k) Vehicular assault, when caused by the operation or driving of a vehicle by a person while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug or by the operation or driving of a vehicle in a reckless manner;
 - (1) Vehicular homicide, when proximately caused by the driving of any vehicle by any person while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug as defined by RCW 46.61.502, or by the operation of any vehicle in a reckless manner;
- 15 (m) Any other class B felony offense with a finding of sexual motivation, as "sexual motivation" is defined under RCW 9.94A.030;
 - (n) Any other felony with a deadly weapon verdict under RCW 9.94A.602; or
 - (o) Any felony offense in effect at any time prior to June 6, 1996, that is comparable to a serious offense, or any federal or out-of-state conviction for an offense that under the laws of this state would be a felony classified as a serious offense.
 - (13) "Law enforcement officer" includes a general authority Washington peace officer as defined in RCW 10.93.020, or a specially commissioned Washington peace officer as defined in RCW 10.93.020. "Law enforcement officer" also includes a limited authority Washington peace officer as defined in RCW 10.93.020 if such officer is duly authorized by his or her employer to carry a concealed pistol.
 - (14) "Felony" means any felony offense under the laws of this state or any federal or out-of-state offense comparable to a felony offense under the laws of this state.
 - (15) "Sell" refers to the actual approval of the delivery of a firearm in consideration of payment or promise of payment of a certain price in money.
- 35 (16) "Barrel length" means the distance from the bolt face of a 36 closed action down the length of the axis of the bore to the crown of 37 the muzzle, or in the case of a barrel with attachments to the end of 38 any legal device permanently attached to the end of the muzzle.

- 1 (17) "Family or household member" means "family" or "household member" as used in RCW 10.99.020.
 - (18) "Assault weapon" means:

- (a) Any semiautomatic pistol or semiautomatic or pump-action rifle or shotgun that is capable of accepting a detachable magazine, with a capacity to accept more then ten rounds of ammunition and that also possesses any of the following:
- 8 <u>(i) If the firearm is a rifle or shotgun, a pistol grip located</u> 9 rear of the trigger;
- (ii) If the firearm is a rifle or shotgun, a stock in any configuration, including but not limited to a thumbhole stock, a folding stock or a telescoping stock, that allows the bearer of the firearm to grasp the firearm with the trigger hand such that the web of the trigger hand, between the thumb and forefinger, can be placed below the top of the external portion of the trigger during firing;
- (iii) If the firearm is a pistol, a shoulder stock of any type or configuration, including but not limited to a folding stock or a telescoping stock;
 - (iv) A barrel shroud;
 - (v) A muzzle brake or muzzle compensator;
- 21 <u>(vi) Any feature capable of functioning as a protruding grip that</u>
 22 <u>can be held by the hand that is not the trigger hand;</u>
- 23 (b) Any pistol that is capable of accepting a detachable magazine 24 at any location outside of the pistol grip;
- (c) Any semiautomatic pistol, any semiautomatic, center-fire rifle,
 or any shotgun with a fixed magazine that has the capacity to accept
 more than ten rounds of ammunition;
 - (d) Any shotgun capable of accepting a detachable magazine;
 - (e) Any shotgun with a revolving cylinder;
- 30 (f) Any conversion kit or other combination of parts from which an 31 assault weapon can be assembled if the parts are in the possession or 32 under the control of any person.
- 33 (19) "Detachable magazine" means a magazine, the function of which 34 is to deliver one or more ammunition cartridges into the firing 35 chamber, which can be removed from the firearm without the use of any 36 tool, including a bullet or ammunition cartridge.
- 37 (20) "Barrel shroud" means a covering, other than a slide, that is 38 attached to, or that substantially or completely encircles, the barrel

- 6 (21) "Muzzle brake" means a device attached to the muzzle of a
 7 weapon that utilizes escaping gas to reduce recoil.
- 8 (22) "Muzzle compensator" means a device attached to the muzzle of 9 a weapon that utilizes escaping gas to control muzzle movement.
- 10 (23) "Conversion kit" means any part or combination of parts
 11 designed and intended for use in converting a firearm into an assault
 12 weapon.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW to read as follows:
- (1) No person in this state shall manufacture, possess, purchase, sell, or otherwise transfer any assault weapon, or any assault weapon conversion kit, except as authorized by subsection (3) of this section.

 Any assault weapon or assault weapon conversion kit the manufacture, possession, purchase, sale, or other transfer of which is prohibited under this section is a public nuisance.
- 21 (2) No person in this state shall possess or have under his or her 22 control at one time both of the following:
 - (a) A semiautomatic or pump-action rifle, semiautomatic pistol, or shotgun capable of accepting a detachable magazine; and
 - (b) Any magazine capable of use with that firearm that contains more than ten rounds of ammunition.
- 27 (3) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to any of the following:
- 29 (a) The possession of an unloaded assault weapon for the purpose of 30 permanently relinquishing it to a law enforcement agency in this state.
- 31 Any assault weapon relinquished pursuant to this subsection shall be destroyed;
- 33 (b) The transfer of any assault weapon by a licensed manufacturer 34 or dealer to a law enforcement agency in this state for use by that 35 agency or its employees for law enforcement purposes;
- 36 (c) The possession of an assault weapon that was legally possessed

on the effective date of this section, but only if the person legally possessing the assault weapon has complied with all of the requirements of subsection (5) of this section;

- (d) The possession of an assault weapon that has been permanently disabled so that it is incapable of discharging a projectile.
 - (4) Subsection (2) of this section shall not apply to any person:
- (a) While lawfully engaged in shooting at a duly licensed, lawfully operated shooting range;
- (b) While lawfully participating in a sporting event officially sanctioned by a club or organization established in whole or in part for the purpose of sponsoring sport shooting events.
- (5) In order to continue to possess an assault weapon that was legally possessed on the effective date of this section, the person possessing the assault weapon shall do all of the following:
- (a) Within ninety days following the effective date of this section, submit to a background check identical to the background check conducted in connection with the purchase of a firearm from a licensed gun dealer;
- (b) Unless the person is prohibited by law from possessing a firearm, immediately register the assault weapon with the sheriff of the county in which the weapon is usually stored;
- (c) Safely and securely store the assault weapon. The sheriff of the county may, no more than once per year, conduct an inspection to ensure compliance with this subsection;
 - (d) Annually renew both the registration and the background check;
- (e) Possess the assault weapon only on property owned or immediately controlled by the person, or while engaged in the legal use of the assault weapon at a duly licensed firing range, or while traveling to or from either of these locations for the purpose of engaging in the legal use of the assault weapon, provided that the assault weapon is stored unloaded and in a separate locked container during transport.
- (6) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, any person in this state who, after the effective date of this section, acquires title to an assault weapon by inheritance, bequest, or succession, shall, within thirty days of acquiring title, do one of the following:
- 37 (a) Comply with all of the requirements of subsection (5) of this 38 section;

- 1 (b) Dispose of the assault weapon pursuant to subsection (3)(a) of this section; or
 - (c) Permanently disable the assault weapon so that it is incapable of discharging a projectile.
 - (7) The sheriff of a county may charge a fee for each registration and for each registration renewal pursuant to subsection (5) of this section. However, such fee may not exceed the costs incurred in administering the registration program established under subsection (5) of this section.
- 10 (8)(a) Any person convicted of violating subsection (1) or (2) of this section is guilty of a class C felony.
 - (b) Any person convicted of violating subsection (5) of this section is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
 - (9) Any violation of this section shall also result in the immediate revocation of the registration of every assault weapon registered to such person.
 - (10) This section does not apply to:

- 21 (b) Members of the armed forces of the United States or of the 22 national guard or organized services, when on duty;
- 23 (c) Officers or employees of the United States duly authorized to 24 possess assault weapons; or
 - (d) Any person engaged in the business of manufacturing, repairing, or dealing in assault weapons, or the representative or agent of the person who is properly licensed under federal or state laws to do so and who is acting within the usual and ordinary course of the business.
