- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A new business may take deductions from the measure of tax 8 during the first thirty-six months of operation of the new business. 9 The deduction is equal to eight thousand three hundred thirty-three
- 10 dollars, multiplied by the number of months in the reporting period.
- 11 (2) As used in this section:
- 12 (a) "New business" means a business that obtains or is required to
 13 obtain a registration certificate under RCW 82.32.030 for the first
 14 time. "New business" also includes a branch location or other facility
 15 established after the effective date of this section by an entity doing
- 16 business in this state;

- (b) "New business" does not include:
- 18 (i) A business that has been restructured, reorganized, or

- transferred, if the activities to be conducted after restructuring, reorganization, or transferral are substantially similar to the
- 3 activities previously conducted; or
- 4 (ii) A business that is substantially similar to a business
- 5 currently operated, or operated within the past five years, by the same
- 6 principals.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect October 1, 2005.
