1 AN ACT Relating to new renewable energy standards; and creating a
2 new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) By July 1, 2007, state agencies must
5 purchase all available anaerobic digestion power from their local
6 utility at the green tag rate.

7 (2) To the extent that a utility purchases power from an anaerobic
8 digestion power producer, the utility must pay the anaerobic digester
9 producer at the green tag rate minus marketing costs.

10 (3) For the purposes of this section, "anaerobic digestion" means
11 a biological process that enables organic matter to be broken down by
12 bacteria in the absence of air to produce a gas principally composed of
13 methane.

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
