30 (2) With the exception of subsection (3) of this section, no person
31 shall be required to pay more than the (~~established~~) annual

34 (3) The department or a city sealer may establish reasonable
35 inspection and testing fees for each type or class of weighing or
36 measuring instrument or device specially requested to be inspected or
37 tested by the device owner. These inspection and testing fees shall be
38 limited to those amounts necessary for the department or city sealer to

1 cover the direct costs associated with such inspection and testing.
2 The fees (~~established under this subsection~~) shall not be set so as
3 to compete with service agents normally engaged in such services.
