1 AN ACT Relating to streamlining Washington state's technology
2 efforts; adding a new section to chapter 28B.38 RCW; adding a new
3 section to chapter 28B.20 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 28B.30
4 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 43.21F RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.38 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 The legislature intends to provide more focus and efficient effort
9 of resources by centralizing technology missions and reducing
10 administrative overhead of the Spokane intercollegiate research and
11 technology institute. The state currently has a variety of entities
12 with conflicting or overlapping missions that cause confusion and
13 wastes tax dollars.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.20 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 The legislature intends to provide more focus and efficient effort
17 of resources by centralizing technology missions and reducing

1 administrative overhead of the Washington technology center. The state
2 currently has a variety of entities with conflicting or overlapping
3 missions that cause confusion and wastes tax dollars.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.30 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The legislature intends to provide more focus and efficient effort
7 of resources by centralizing technology missions and reducing
8 administrative overhead of the Washington State University energy
9 program. The state currently has a variety of entities with
10 conflicting or overlapping missions that cause confusion and wastes tax
11 dollars.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21F RCW
13 to read as follows:

14 The legislature intends to provide more focus and efficient effort
15 of resources by centralizing technology missions and reducing
16 administrative overhead of the department of community, trade, and
17 economic development's energy policy office. The state currently has
18 a variety of entities with conflicting or overlapping missions that
19 cause confusion and wastes tax dollars.
