- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.84.030 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.84.030 are each amended to read as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of disorderly conduct if ((he)) the person:
- 7 (a) Uses abusive language and thereby intentionally creates a risk 8 of assault; ((or))
- 9 (b) Intentionally disrupts any lawful assembly or meeting of 10 persons without lawful authority; ((or))
- 11 (c) Intentionally obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic without lawful authority; or
- 13 (d)(i) Engages in fighting or in tumultuous conduct or makes
- 14 unreasonable noise and continues to do so after being asked to stop,
- 15 within five hundred feet of:
- 16 (A) The location where a funeral or burial is being performed;
- 17 (B) A funeral home during the viewing of a deceased person;
- 18 (C) A funeral procession, if the person described in this
