1 AN ACT Relating to school employees convicted of or pleading guilty
2 to sex crimes; and amending RCW 43.43.845.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.845 and 1990 c 33 s 577 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) Upon a guilty plea or conviction of a person of any felony
7 crime involving the physical neglect of a child under chapter 9A.42
8 RCW, the physical injury or death of a child under chapter 9A.32 or
9 9A.36 RCW (except motor vehicle violations under chapter 46.61 RCW),
10 sexual exploitation of a child under chapter 9.68A RCW, sexual offenses
11 under chapter 9A.44 RCW (~~where a minor is the victim~~), promoting
12 prostitution of a minor under chapter 9A.88 RCW, or the sale or
13 purchase of a minor child under RCW 9A.64.030, the prosecuting attorney
14 shall determine whether the person holds a certificate or permit issued
15 under chapters 28A.405 and 28A.410 RCW or is employed by a school
16 district. If the person is employed by a school district or holds a
17 certificate or permit issued under chapters 28A.405 and 28A.410 RCW,
18 the prosecuting attorney shall notify the state patrol of such guilty
19 pleas or convictions.

1 (2) When the state patrol receives information that a person who
2 has a certificate or permit issued under chapters 28A.405 and 28A.410
3 RCW or is employed by a school district has pled guilty to or been
4 convicted of one of the felony crimes under subsection (1) of this
5 section, the state patrol shall immediately transmit that information
6 to the superintendent of public instruction. It shall be the duty of
7 the superintendent of public instruction to provide this information to
8 the state board of education and the school district employing the
9 individual who pled guilty or was convicted of the crimes identified in
10 subsection (1) of this section.
