- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.41 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Hospitals shall have in place policies to assure that, when
- 7 appropriate, information about unanticipated outcomes is provided to
- 8 patients or their families or any surrogate decision makers identified
- 9 pursuant to RCW 7.70.065. Notifications of unanticipated outcomes
- 10 under this section do not constitute an acknowledgement or admission of
- 11 liability, nor can the fact of notification, the content disclosed, or
- 12 any and all statements, affirmations, gestures, or conduct expressing
- 13 apology be introduced as evidence in a civil action.
- 14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Beginning January 1, 2006, the department
- 15 shall, during the survey of a hospital, ensure that the policy required
- 16 in section 1 of this act is in place.

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
