- 1 AN ACT Relating to the use of mercury-containing vaccines; and 2 adding a new section to chapter 70.95M RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.95M RCW 5 to read as follows:
- (1) Beginning July 1, 2006, a person who is known to be pregnant or who is under three years of age shall not be vaccinated with a mercury-containing product that does not meet food and drug administration vaccine licensure
- 10 requirements.
- 11 (2) The secretary of the department of health may, upon declaration
- 12 of a public health emergency, suspend the requirements of this section
- 13 for the duration of the emergency.
