1 AN ACT Relating to limiting liability for persons who work with
2 liquefied petroleum gas; and adding a new section to chapter 4.24 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 A person who sells at retail, supplies, handles, or transports
7 liquefied petroleum gas is not liable for civil damages for death,
8 injury, or loss of property caused by:

9 (1) The installation, alteration, modification, or repair of
10 liquefied petroleum gas equipment or a liquefied petroleum gas
11 appliance if the installation, alteration, modification, or repair was
12 done without the constructive knowledge and consent of the person
13 selling, supplying, handling, or transporting liquefied petroleum gas;
14 or

15 (2) The use of liquefied petroleum gas equipment or a liquefied
16 petroleum gas appliance in a manner or for a purpose other than that
17 for which the equipment or appliance was intended or foreseeable and

1 that could not reasonably have been expected.
