- 1 AN ACT Relating to employment rights of peace corps and
- 2 humanitarian organization volunteers and faith-based missionaries; and
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 41.06 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.06 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- Any exempt or nonexempt full-time permanent employee who leaves employment to serve in the United States peace corps or to participate
- 9 in a program sponsored by a humanitarian organization or to participate 10 in a faith-based mission, upon return shall be restored to his or her
- 11 previous position or an equivalent one. In addition, the person shall
- 12 be considered as having been on furlough or leave of absence during his
- or her period of service in the peace corps and shall be restored to
- 14 the position without loss of seniority. The person shall be entitled
- 15 to participate in insurance, vacations, retirement pay, and other
- 16 benefits offered by the employer under established rules and practices
- 17 relating to employees on furlough or leave of absence in effect with
- 18 the employer at the time the person left for service in the peace
