- AN ACT Relating to dead animal disposal; amending RCW 16.68.020;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 16.36 RCW; and recodifying RCW
- 3 16.68.020.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 16.68.020 and 1949 c 100 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Every person owning or having in charge any ((animal)) <u>livestock</u>
- 8 that has died ((or been killed on account)) because of disease shall
- 9 ((immediately bury)) dispose of the carcass ((thereof to such a depth
- 10 that no part of the carcass shall be nearer than three feet from the
- 11 surface of the ground)) within a time frame and in a manner prescribed
- 12 <u>in rule by the director, which may include, but is not limited to,</u>
- 13 burial, composting, incinerating, landfilling, natural decomposition,
- or rendering. Any ((animal)) livestock found dead ((shall be)) from an
- 15 unknown cause is presumed to have died ((from and on account)) because
- 16 of disease.
