- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department shall create, by rule, a program to provide 7 offenders with the opportunity to participate in programs designed to 8 educate offenders on American citizenship and civil rights. The 9 program shall include, but not be limited to educational components on 10 the following:
- 11 (a) Responsible citizenship;
- 12 (b) Rights lost to felony offenders and restoration, including gun 13 ownership and possession;
  - (c) Voting laws and felony voting rights restoration;
- 15 (d) Legal financial obligations;
- 16 (e) Sex offender registration and community notification; and
- 17 (f) Civic participation, including participation in local, state,
- 18 and federal government processes, school boards, neighborhood
- 19 organizations, and nonprofit or volunteer organizations.

- 1 (2) Upon satisfactory completion of a program, the department shall issue a certificate of completion to an offender.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW 4 to read as follows:

- (1) The department shall provide to offenders, before release into the community, information regarding community service providers that provide educational services to offenders.
- (2) The department shall work in collaboration with community service providers that provide educational services to offenders to develop a standard curriculum for education of offenders released into the community.
