- 1 AN ACT Relating to allowing spas and art galleries to serve wine to

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.12 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Nothing in this title applies to or prevents a spa or art

gallery from offering or supplying without charge wine by the

- 9 individual glass to a customer for consumption on the premises.
- 10 However, the customer must be at least twenty-one years of age and may
- only be offered one glass of wine, and the wine must have been legally
- 12 purchased under this title. If the wine is offered by a spa that
- 13 provides massages, the wine may not be offered to the customer until
- 14 the massage is completed.

- 15 (2) For the purposes of this section, "spa" means a business that
- 16 offers beauty services including, but not limited to, shampooing,
- 17 cutting, styling, or dyeing hair, manicures, pedicures, facials,
- 18 massages, and the use of body toning equipment.

- 1 (3) For purposes of this section, "art gallery" means a room or 2 building devoted to the exhibition and/or sale of the works of art.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 66.12 RCW 4 to read as follows:
- 5 The board may adopt rules to implement section 1 of this act.
