- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature intends to clarify the

process for the determination of parentage in this state in response to

- 7 Docket Number 75626-1 (2005). In that case, the court held that
- 8 Washington's common law recognizes the status of de facto parents and
- 9 grants them standing to petition for a determination of the rights and
- 10 responsibilities that accompany legal parentage in Washington state.
- 11 The legislature intends to preempt the common law and clarify that
- 12 chapter 26.26 RCW governs every determination of parentage in this
- 13 state without exception.
- 14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 26.26.021 and 2002 c 302 s 103 are each amended to read as follows:
- 16 (1) This chapter governs every determination of parentage in this
- 17 state and provides the exclusive means for determining parentage in
- 18 this state.

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- 1 (2) The court shall apply the law of this state to adjudicate the 2 parent-child relationship. The applicable law does not depend on:
 - (a) The place of birth of the child; or

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- (b) The past or present residence of the child.
- (3) This chapter does not create, enlarge, or diminish parental rights or duties under other law of this state.
- (4) If a birth results under a surrogate parentage contract that is unenforceable under the law of this state, the parent-child relationship is determined as provided in RCW 26.26.101 through 26.26.116.

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
