1 AN ACT Relating to community protection zones; and adding a new
2 section to chapter 9.94A RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.94A RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) A county may establish a community protection zone, as defined
7 under RCW 9.94A.030 for an offender convicted of a sex offense.

8 (2) A county may enact a rule or ordinance prohibiting an offender
9 convicted of a sex offense from residing near a public or private
10 school, playground, public swimming pool, day care center, organized
11 campground, community center, and any other facility whose primary
12 purpose is the education or care of persons under eighteen years of
13 age.

14 (3) Any county may enact such a rule or ordinance, or may designate
15 specific areas where an offender convicted of a sex offense may reside.
