

**HB 3293-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/03/06)

Declares that a person is guilty of disorderly conduct if the person: (1) Intentionally engages in fighting or in tumultuous conduct or makes unreasonable noise, within five hundred feet of: (a) The location where a funeral or burial is being performed; (b) a funeral home during the viewing of a deceased person; (c) a funeral procession, if the person knows that the funeral procession is taking place; or (d) a building in which a funeral or memorial service is being conducted; and (2) Knows that the activity adversely affects the funeral, burial, viewing, funeral procession, or memorial service.
