1 On page 4, after line 20, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter
3 43.105 RCW to read as follows:

4 (1) By September 1, 2007, the department shall survey all
5 desktop computers owned by the state and identify which desktop
6 computers are suitable for using power management software.

7 (2) After conducting the review under subsection (1) of this
8 section, the department shall purchase power management software
9 for all desktop computers owned by the state that have been
10 identified by the department as suitable for using power management
11 software. The power management software must be purchased
12 according to the terms of the master contract number T06-MST-002
13 effective July 7, 2006, or a subsequent contract entered into by
14 the state for power management software that offers comparable or
15 better energy efficiency savings.

16 (3) The department must install power management software on
17 all desktop computers as expeditiously as possible.

18 (4) When acquiring new desktop computers, the department must
19 purchase and install power management software at the time of
20 acquisition, unless power management software is not suitable for
21 a particular desktop computer's intended use.

22 (5) The department may retain any rebate moneys the state
23 receives for energy conservation resulting from utilization of the
24 power management software.

25 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** By December 1st of each year, the
26 department of information services shall report to the legislature
27 on the number of licenses installed, the amount of estimated energy
28 saved per computer per year, as well as the amount and number of

1 rebates received by the state as a result of implementing the power
2 management software.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** Sections 5 and 6 of this act expire July
4 1, 2017."

6 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct
7 internal references accordingly.

8 Correct the title.

9 EFFECT: Requires the Department of Information Services (DIS)
10 to survey all desktop computers owned by the state and identify
11 which computers are suitable for using power management software.
12 Requires the DIS to purchase and install power management software
13 for all desktop computers owned by the state that are suitable for
14 such use as determined by the DIS. Requires the DIS to acquire
15 power management software for all new desktop computers, if
16 suitable. Allows the DIS to retain any energy conservation rebates
17 the state receives as a result of utilization of the power
18 management software. Requires the DIS to report annually to the
19 Legislature on the number of licenses installed, the estimated
20 amount of energy saved, and the amount and number of rebates
21 received by the state.
