2 "Sec. 18. RCW 18.71.017 and 2000 c 171 s 23 are each amended
3 to read as follows:

4 (1) The commission may adopt such rules as are not inconsistent
5 with the laws of this state as may be determined necessary or
6 proper to carry out the purposes of this chapter. The commission
7 is the successor in interest of the board of medical examiners and
8 the medical disciplinary board. All contracts, undertakings,
9 agreements, rules, regulations, and policies continue in full force
10 and effect on July 1, 1994, unless otherwise repealed or rejected
11 by this chapter or by the commission.

12 (2) The commission may adopt rules governing office based
13 sedation and anesthesia performed by persons licensed under this
14 chapter, including necessary training, and equipment.

15 **Sec. 19.** RCW 18.57.005 and 1986 c 259 s 94 are each amended to
16 read as follows:

17 The board shall have the following powers and duties:

18 (1) To administer examinations to applicants for licensure
19 under this chapter;

20 (2) To make such rules and regulations as are not inconsistent
21 with the laws of this state as may be deemed necessary or proper to
22 carry out the purposes of this chapter;

23 (3) To establish and administer requirements for continuing
24 professional education as may be necessary or proper to insure the
25 public health and safety as a prerequisite to granting and renewing
26 licenses under this chapter: PROVIDED, That such rules shall not
27 require a licensee under this chapter to engage in continuing
28 education related to or provided by any specific branch, school, or
29 philosophy of medical practice or its political and/or professional
30 organizations, associations, or societies;

1 (4) To adopt rules governing office based sedation and
2 anesthesia performed by persons licensed under this chapter,
3 including necessary training, and equipment;

4 (5) To keep an official record of all its proceedings, which
5 record shall be evidence of all proceedings of the board which are
6 set forth therein.

7 **Sec. 20.** RCW 18.22.015 and 1990 c 147 s 5 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 The board shall:

10 (1) Administer all laws placed under its jurisdiction;

11 (2) Prepare, grade, and administer or determine the nature,
12 grading, and administration of examinations for applicants for
13 podiatric physician and surgeon licenses;

14 (3) Examine and investigate all applicants for podiatric
15 physician and surgeon licenses and certify to the secretary all
16 applicants it judges to be properly qualified;

17 (4) Adopt any rules which it considers necessary or proper to
18 carry out the purposes of this chapter;

19 (5) Adopt rules governing office based sedation and anesthesia
20 performed by persons licensed under this chapter, including
21 necessary training, and equipment;

22 (6) Determine which schools of podiatric medicine and surgery
23 will be approved."

EFFECT: Authorizes the Medical Quality Assurance Commission,
the Podiatric Medical Board, and the State Board of Osteopathic
Medicine and Surgery to adopt rules to govern office based
sedation and anesthesia.
