

SHB 1179 - H AMD 130

1 On page 3, after line 10, insert the following:

2 "(c) An institution of higher education may award a state need
3 grant to an eligible student enrolled in three to six credit-
4 bearing quarter credits, or the semester equivalent, on a
5 provisional basis if:

6 (i) The student has not previously received a state need grant
7 from that institution;

8 (ii)The student completes the required free application for
9 federal student aid;

10 (iii) The institution has reviewed of the student's financial
11 condition, and the financial condition of the student's family if
12 the student is a dependent student, and has determined that the
13 student is likely eligible for a state need grant; and

14 (iv) The student has signed a document attesting to the fact
15 that the financial information provided on the free application for
16 federal student aid and any additional financial information
17 provided directly to the institution is accurate and complete, and
18 that the student agrees to repay the institution for the grant
19 amount if the student submitted false or incomplete information."

EFFECT: Adds the ability for a student taking three to six credits to be awarded a provisional state need grant if: he or she has not previously received a state need grant from that institution; completes the free application for federal student aid; is determined to be likely eligible; and signs a document agreeing to repay the funds if inaccurate information was provided.
