2 "tools" on line 37 and insert:

3 "Participate in the Washington climate change challenge
4 established by executive order 07-02, and discuss the feasibility
5 of using a life-cycle model to identify a project's carbon
6 emissions, identify ways to reduce the carbon footprint of state
7 transportation projects, and give specific consideration to
8 alternative approaches for reducing carbon emissions, including
9 low-carbon fuels, reduction in vehicle miles traveled, investments
10 in public transportation, techniques in demand management, and
11 other efficiency tools"

EFFECT: Removes the department of transportation's duty to assess the life-cycle carbon emissions and alternative approaches for reducing carbon emissions of certain transportation projects, and requires that the department participate in the climate change challenge established by executive order, to specifically discuss the feasibility of using a life-cycle model for identifying a project's carbon emissions and to identify ways to reduce the carbon footprint of state transportation projects.
