1 On page 1, line 10, after "(2)" strike all material through
2 "immediately." on page 2, line 1, and insert "The following
3 definitions apply to this section.

4 (a) "Agency shop fees" are fees paid by nonmember employees to
5 a labor organization for the costs related to collective
6 bargaining, contract administration, and activity related to
7 matters affecting wages, hours, and other conditions of employment
8 done by the labor organization on behalf of all employees.

9 (b) "Use of agency shop fees" includes the use of agency shop
10 fees and the use of any funds that are commingled with agency shop
11 fees.

12 (c) "Expenditures to influence an election" includes, but is
13 not limited to, expenditures for staff whose duties affect
14 elections or have the responsibility of training other staff or
15 volunteers to affect elections; expenditures on communication
16 efforts internally or externally to advance or oppose one or more
17 candidates or ballot measures; expenditures to assist voter turn
18 out; expenditures for staff to aid in recruiting or training
19 candidates; expenditures for staff or materials to prepare ballot
20 measures or recall efforts; expenditures for staff or legal
21 services to contest election results; and donations of funds to
22 organizations or individuals that make expenditures to influence an
23 election.

24 (d) "To operate a political committee" means expenditures on
25 staff work, promotional materials, professional services, and
26 internal communication efforts that aid in the operation and
27 funding of a political committee.

28 (e) "Affirmatively authorized" means that the nonmember signed
29 a declaration within the twelve month period prior to the
30 expenditure indicating consent to the labor organization's use of
31 the fees to influence an election."

1 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Adds definitions of "agency shop fees", "use of agency shop fees", "expenditures to influence and election", "to operate a political committee", and "affirmatively authorized"; removes language from original bill defining when an agency does not use agency shop fees; removes the emergency clause.
