

**2SHB 2098 - H AMD 117**

1 On page 20, after line 35, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 22.** The legislature finds that there is a  
3 significant disconnect in the state's medicaid program between  
4 recipients and those delivering and paying for their care.  
5 Medicaid recipients are not empowered to make decisions regarding  
6 their own health care needs. Nor are there incentives for medicaid  
7 recipients to be prudent purchasers of health care. The  
8 legislature further finds that there are a significant number of  
9 medicaid recipients who are only temporarily on medicaid and will  
10 need to transition to employer- sponsored health insurance or  
11 purchase health care in the private market.

12 The federal deficit reduction act of 2005 allows states to  
13 redesign their medicaid programs, creating more flexibility in  
14 benefit and cost-sharing designs and giving enrollees more  
15 opportunity to decide how they use their health care benefits.  
16 Specifically, the deficit reduction act allows for ten states to  
17 operate medicaid demonstration programs to test alternative systems  
18 to deliver medicaid benefits through a health opportunity account  
19 in combination with a high deductible health plan. Washington  
20 state should continue to be a leader in health care policy and  
21 submit a state plan amendment to the center for medicaid and  
22 medicare to be one of the ten states to implement a health  
23 opportunity account demonstration program.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 23.** The department of social and health  
25 services shall submit a state plan amendment to the center for  
26 medicaid and medicare services to be one of the ten states to  
27 operate a medicaid demonstration program to test alternative  
28 systems to deliver medicaid benefits through a health opportunity  
29 account. The state plan amendment shall be in compliance with

1 federal deficit reduction act of 2005 and other rules or directives  
2 provided by the center for medicaid and medicare services. The  
3 state plan amendment shall also identify individuals eligible to  
4 receive transitional medical assistance as the target population to  
5 participate, on a voluntary basis, in this demonstration project."

6 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct internal  
7 references accordingly, and correct the title.

**EFFECT:** Directs the Department of Social and Health Services  
to seek federal approval to establish a voluntary health  
opportunity account demonstration project.
