8 On page 221, after line 11, insert the following:

9 "(j) Amounts appropriated in this section are sufficient to fund
10 the cost of cost of living adjustments provided in section 504 of
11 this act. The office of the superintendent of public instruction
12 shall adjust accordingly any internal references and the
13 appropriate formula allocation factors in sections 501-515 of this
14 act. Furthermore, the office of the superintendent of public
15 instruction is hereby granted authority to transfer appropriations
16 among sections 501-515 of this act the extent required to fund the
17 costs of the cost of living adjustments in other sections."

19 On page 299, line 7, increase the general fund-state
20 appropriation for fiscal year 2009 by \$8,158,000.

21 On page 299, line 11, correct the total.

23 On page 301, after line 30, insert the following:

24 "(14) \$8,158,000 for fiscal year 2009 is provided solely for the
25 early childhood education and assistance program for additional
26 enhancements as determined by the department of early learning."

EFFECT: Provides the additional 1% COLA just to classified staff, excluding administrative staff and certificated instructional staff. Adds \$8.1 million for the ECEAP program supporting early childhood programs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Reduces General Fund-State by \$29,158,000.
