- 7 On page 199, line 13, increase the general fund-state 8 appropriation for fiscal year 2009 by \$126,000

- 11 On page 206, after line 22, insert the following:
- "(xxi) \$126,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for 12 fiscal year 2009 is provided solely for the office of the 13 superintendent of public instruction to contract with a national 14 15 organization to establish, maintain, and operate an endowment for 16 the promotion of geography education in Washington state. The national organization must have experience operating geography 17 education endowments in other states and must provide equal 18 nonstate matching funds to the state funds provided in the 19 20 contract. All funds in and any interest earned on the endowment shall be used exclusively for geography education programs. The 21 2.2 national organization must have an established affiliated advisory committee in the state to recommend local projects to be funded by 23 the endowment. The contract shall require that the organization 24 25 report annually to the superintendent on the recipients of

- 1 endowment funds and the amounts and purposes of expenditures from
- 2 the fund."

EFFECT: Removes funding (\$126,000 GF-S) for Second Substitute House Bill 2683 (affordable housing for all). Provides \$126,000 GF-S for a geography education endowment through the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
