1 On page 1, beginning on line 11 of the amendment, strike all of  
2 section 2 and insert the following:

3 "Sec. 2. RCW 46.16.313 and 2005 c 426 s 3, 2005 c 225 s 3, 2005 c  
4 224 s 3, 2005 c 220 s 3, 2005 c 216 s 3, 2005 c 177 s 3, 2005 c 85 s 3,  
5 2005 c 71 s 3, 2005 c 53 s 3, 2005 c 48 s 3, 2005 c 44 s 3, and 2005 c  
6 42 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

7 (1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty  
8 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW  
9 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section  
10 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the  
11 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration  
12 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to  
13 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been  
14 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by  
15 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to  
16 the motor vehicle fund.

17 (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
18 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a  
19 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars.  
20 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of  
21 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and  
22 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be  
23 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
24 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the  
25 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in  
26 RCW 28B.10.890.

27 (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
28 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate  
29 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall  
30 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under

1 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by  
2 it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the  
3 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state  
4 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license  
5 plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

6 (4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
7 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a  
8 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of  
9 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed  
10 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
11 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
12 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to  
13 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments  
14 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as  
15 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary  
16 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW  
17 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds  
18 to the state general fund.

19 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
20 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special  
21 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The  
22 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee  
23 collected under this subsection for administration and collection  
24 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed  
25 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest  
26 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium,  
27 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary  
28 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW  
29 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds  
30 to the state general fund.

31 (6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on  
32 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
33 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a  
34 professional fire fighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an  
35 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount  
36 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this  
37 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.  
38 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state

1 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW  
2 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor  
3 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been  
4 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional fire fighters  
5 and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the  
6 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall  
7 credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters  
8 benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

9 (7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January  
10 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
11 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional fire  
12 fighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a  
13 fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to  
14 exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
15 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
16 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a  
17 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state  
18 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
19 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
20 cost of implementing the professional fire fighters and paramedics  
21 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that  
22 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds  
23 to the Washington State Council of Fire Fighters benevolent fund  
24 established under RCW 46.16.30902.

25 (8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on  
26 November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
27 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a  
28 "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty  
29 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve  
30 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
31 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be  
32 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
33 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
34 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
35 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
36 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate.  
37 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been

1 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping  
2 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.

3 (9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November  
4 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
5 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak"  
6 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars.  
7 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each  
8 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection  
9 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to  
10 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed  
11 report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit  
12 the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department  
13 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of  
14 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the  
15 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
16 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account  
17 established under RCW 46.16.30904.

18 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on  
19 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
20 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law  
21 enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty  
22 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve  
23 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
24 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall  
25 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
26 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
27 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
28 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
29 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license  
30 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has  
31 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law  
32 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

33 (11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January  
34 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon  
35 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement  
36 memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty  
37 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two  
38 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration

1 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall  
2 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
3 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
4 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
5 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
6 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license  
7 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has  
8 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law  
9 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

10 (12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
11 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
12 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
13 of a Washington's Wildlife collection license plate shall pay an  
14 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount  
15 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this  
16 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.  
17 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state  
18 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW  
19 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor  
20 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been  
21 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife  
22 license plate collection. Upon determination by the department that  
23 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds  
24 to the state wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife  
25 account from the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate  
26 collection may be used only for the department of fish and wildlife's  
27 game species management activities.

28 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
29 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
30 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington's  
31 Wildlife collection license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of  
32 thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed  
33 two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
34 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
35 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a  
36 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state  
37 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
38 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the

1 cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife license plate  
2 collection. Upon determination by the department that the state has  
3 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state  
4 wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from  
5 the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate collection may be  
6 used only for the department of fish and wildlife's game species  
7 management activities.

8 (c) In addition to the fees imposed under (a) and (b) of this  
9 subsection, a two-dollar fee shall be imposed on each initial  
10 application and renewal under this subsection and shall be deposited  
11 into the wildlife rehabilitation account created in section 3 of this  
12 act.

13 (13)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
14 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
15 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
16 of a Washington state parks and recreation commission special license  
17 plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall  
18 deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected  
19 under this subsection for administration and collection expenses  
20 incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody  
21 of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.  
22 Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to  
23 the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the  
24 state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington  
25 state parks and recreation commission special license plate. Upon  
26 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
27 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state parks education and  
28 enhancement account established in RCW 79A.05.059.

29 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
30 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
31 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington  
32 state parks and recreation commission special license plate shall, upon  
33 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct  
34 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this  
35 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.  
36 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state  
37 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW  
38 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor

1 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been  
2 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington state parks and  
3 recreation commission special license plate. Upon determination by the  
4 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall  
5 credit the proceeds to the state parks education and enhancement  
6 account established in RCW 79A.05.059.

7 (14)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
8 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
9 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
10 of a "Washington Lighthouses" license plate shall pay an initial fee of  
11 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed  
12 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
13 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
14 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a  
15 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state  
16 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
17 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
18 cost of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. Upon  
19 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
20 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental  
21 programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912.

22 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
23 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
24 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Washington  
25 Lighthouses" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty  
26 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two  
27 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
28 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be  
29 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
30 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer  
31 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the  
32 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost  
33 of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. Upon  
34 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
35 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental  
36 programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912.

37 (15)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
38 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required

1 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
2 of a "Keep Kids Safe" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty-  
3 five dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed  
4 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
5 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
6 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with  
7 a proper identifying report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
8 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
9 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
10 cost of implementing the "Keep Kids Safe" license plate. Upon  
11 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
12 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the children's trust fund  
13 established under RCW 43.121.100.

14 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
15 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
16 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Keep Kids  
17 Safe" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty  
18 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two  
19 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
20 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall  
21 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
22 identifying report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer  
23 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the  
24 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost  
25 of implementing the "Keep Kids Safe" license plate. Upon determination  
26 by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer  
27 shall credit the proceeds to the children's trust fund established  
28 under RCW 43.121.100.

29 (16)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
30 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
31 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
32 of a "we love our pets" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty  
33 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve  
34 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administrative  
35 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall  
36 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
37 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
38 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until



1 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
2 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon  
3 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
4 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the we love our pets account  
5 established under RCW 46.16.30915.

6 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
7 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
8 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "we love our  
9 pets" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty  
10 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two  
11 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
12 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall  
13 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
14 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state  
15 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
16 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
17 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon  
18 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
19 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the we love our pets account  
20 established under RCW 46.16.30915.

21 (17)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
22 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
23 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
24 of a "Gonzaga University alumni association" license plate shall pay an  
25 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount  
26 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this  
27 subsection for administrative and collection expenses incurred by it.  
28 The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state  
29 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW  
30 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor  
31 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been  
32 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Gonzaga University alumni  
33 association" license plate. Upon determination by the department that  
34 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds  
35 to the Gonzaga University alumni association account established under  
36 RCW 46.16.30917.

37 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
38 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid

1 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Gonzaga  
2 University alumni association" license plate shall, upon application,  
3 pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not  
4 to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
5 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
6 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with  
7 a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the  
8 state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account  
9 until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for  
10 the cost of implementing the "Gonzaga University alumni association"  
11 license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has  
12 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Gonzaga  
13 University alumni association account established under RCW  
14 46.16.30917.

15 (18) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on  
16 or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to  
17 be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of  
18 a "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall pay an initial  
19 fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to  
20 exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
21 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
22 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a  
23 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state  
24 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
25 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the  
26 cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park Fund" license  
27 plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been  
28 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the  
29 "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under RCW  
30 46.16.30919.

31 (19) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or  
32 after January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be  
33 paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a  
34 "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall, upon  
35 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct  
36 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this  
37 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.  
38 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state

1 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW  
2 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor  
3 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been  
4 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park  
5 Fund" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the  
6 state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to  
7 the "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under RCW  
8 46.16.30919.

9 (20)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
10 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
11 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
12 of an armed forces license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty  
13 dollars. The department shall retain an amount not to exceed twelve  
14 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration  
15 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be  
16 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper  
17 identifying report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall  
18 credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department  
19 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of  
20 implementing the armed forces special license plate collection. Upon  
21 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the  
22 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the veterans stewardship account  
23 established under RCW 43.60A.140.

24 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after  
25 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid  
26 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of an armed forces  
27 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars.  
28 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each  
29 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection  
30 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to  
31 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying report.  
32 Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to  
33 the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the  
34 state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the armed forces  
35 special license plate collection. Upon the determination by the  
36 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall  
37 credit the proceeds to the veterans stewardship account established in  
38 RCW 43.60A.140.

1 (21)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due  
2 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required  
3 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder  
4 of a "Ski & Ride Washington" license plate shall pay an initial fee of  
5 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed  
6 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for  
7 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining  
8 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a  
9 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state  
10 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until  
11 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
