

ESSB 6760 - H AMD TO CB COMM AMD (H-5880.1/08) **1528**

1 On page 1 of the striking amendment, strike all material after
2 line 2 and insert the following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 71A.20.170 and 2005 c 353 s 1 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) The developmental disabilities community trust account is
6 created in the state treasury. All net proceeds from the use of
7 excess property identified in the 2002 joint legislative audit and
8 review committee capital study or other studies of the division of
9 developmental disabilities residential habilitation centers at
10 Lakeland Village, Yakima Valley school, Francis Hadden Morgan
11 Center, and Rainier school that would not impact current
12 residential habilitation center operations must be deposited into
13 the account. (~~(Income)~~)

14 (2) Proceeds may come from the lease of the land, conservation
15 easements, sale of timber, or other activities short of sale of the
16 property.

17 (3) "Excess property" includes that portion of the property at
18 Rainier school previously under the cognizance and control of
19 Washington State University for use as a dairy/forage research
20 facility. (~~("Proceeds" include the net receipts from the use of~~
21 ~~all or a portion of the properties.))~~)

22 (4) Only investment income from the principal of the proceeds
23 deposited into the trust account may be spent from the account.
24 For purposes of this section, "investment income" includes lease
25 payments, rent payments, or other periodic payments deposited into
26 the trust account. For purposes of this section, "principal" is
27 the actual excess land from which proceeds are assigned to the
28 trust account.

29 (5) Moneys in the account may be spent only after
30 appropriation. Expenditures from the account shall be used
31 exclusively to provide family support and/or employment/day

1 services to eligible persons with developmental disabilities who
2 can be served by community-based developmental disability services.
3 It is the intent of the legislature that the account should not be
4 used to replace, supplant, or reduce existing appropriations.

5 ~~((2) The department shall report on its efforts and strategies
6 to provide income to the developmental disabilities community trust
7 account from the excess property identified in subsection (1) of
8 this section from the lease of the property, sale of timber, or
9 other activity short of sale of the property. The department shall
10 report by June 30, 2006))~~

11 ~~((3))~~ (6) The account shall be known as the Dan Thompson memorial
12 developmental disabilities community trust account."

EFFECT: Removes Fircrest School as a residential habilitation center that can have proceeds from its excess property placed into the Dan Thompson account. Clarifies that real property is not deposited into the Dan Thompson Account.
