1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) Subject to funding provided specifically for the purposes of
6 this section, the state board for community and technical colleges, in
7 consultation with the exclusive bargaining representative of individual
8 providers under RCW 74.39A.270, shall allocate capital grants on a
9 competitive basis to up to four community college pilot sites for the
10 delivery of training and workforce development services for long-term
11 care workers required under chapter 74.39A RCW. Moneys must be used to
12 renovate or expand existing community college facilities, or to acquire
13 land and facilities in close proximity to a community college campus,
14 to accommodate programs that provide home and community-like long-term
15 care settings, including the installation of durable medical equipment
16 such as assistive devices, lifts, and remote technologies. Community
17 colleges eligible to participate in the pilot program must be located
18 in a county with a population of two hundred thousand or more.
19 Priority consideration must be given to community college applicants:
20 (a) With existing allied health care programs; and (b) that can
21 demonstrate tangible commitments to the project by business or other
22 community partners.

23 (2) This section expires July 1, 2015.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW
25 to read as follows:

26 By December 1, 2014, the state board for community and technical
27 colleges shall file a report with the capital budget and higher
28 education committees of the legislature regarding the pilot program

1 created in section 1 of this act. With respect to each community
2 college pilot site, the report shall include the following:

3 (1) The number of long-term care workers trained prior to the
4 college's participation in the pilot program and duration or extent of
5 such training;

6 (2) The number of long-term care workers trained subsequent to the
7 college's participation in the pilot program and duration or extent of
8 such training;

9 (3) The identity of community and business partners providing
10 tangible commitments to each pilot site, together with a detailed
11 description of those tangible commitments; and

12 (4) The amount of the grant moneys received, dates of receipt, and
13 a detailed description, including costs, of the renovation, expansion,
14 and acquisitions associated with the grant moneys.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
16 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
17 June 30, 2008, in the omnibus appropriations act or the omnibus capital
18 appropriations act, this act is null and void."
