1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 43.101.220 and 1981 c 136 s 26 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) The corrections personnel of the state and all counties and
6 municipal corporations initially employed on or after January 1, 1982,
7 shall engage in basic corrections training which complies with
8 standards adopted by the commission (~~pursuant to RCW 43.101.160~~).
9 The training shall be successfully completed during the first six
10 months of employment of the personnel, unless otherwise extended or
11 waived by the commission, and shall be requisite to the continuation of
12 employment.

13 ~~(2) ((The corrections personnel of the state and all counties and
14 municipal corporations transferred or promoted to a supervisory or
15 management position on or after January 1, 1982, shall engage in
16 supervisory and/or management training which complies with standards
17 adopted by the commission pursuant to RCW 43.101.160. The training
18 shall be successfully completed prior to or within the first six months
19 of employment, unless otherwise extended or waived by the commission,
20 and shall be requisite to the continuation of employment.~~

21 ~~(3))~~ The commission shall provide the training required in this
22 section, together with facilities, supplies, materials, and the room
23 and board for noncommuting attendees.

24 ~~((4))~~ (3) Nothing in this section shall affect or impair the
25 employment status of any employee whose employer does not provide him
26 with the opportunity to engage in the required training.

27 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.101.350 and 1997 c 351 s 10 are each amended to
28 read as follows:

29 (1) All law enforcement personnel initially hired to, transferred

1 to, or promoted to a supervisory or management position on or after
2 January 1, 1999, and all corrections personnel of the state and all
3 counties and municipal corporations transferred or promoted to a
4 supervisory or management position on or after January 1, 1982, shall,
5 within the first six months of entry into the position, successfully
6 complete the core training requirements prescribed by rule of the
7 commission for the position, or obtain a waiver or extension of the
8 core training requirements from the commission.

9 (2) Within one year after completion of the core training
10 requirements of this section, all law enforcement personnel and
11 corrections personnel shall successfully complete all remaining
12 requirements for career level certification prescribed by rule of the
13 commission applicable to their position or rank, or obtain a waiver or
14 extension of the career level training requirements from the
15 commission.

16 (3) The commission shall provide the training required in this
17 section, together with facilities, supplies, materials, and the room
18 and board for attendees who do not live within fifty miles of the
19 training center. The training shall be delivered in the least
20 disruptive manner to local law enforcement or corrections agencies, and
21 will include but not be limited to regional on-site training,
22 interactive training, and credit for training given by the home
23 department.

24 (4) Nothing in this section affects or impairs the employment
25 status of an employee whose employer does not provide the opportunity
26 to engage in the required training."

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27 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "training;" strike the
28 remainder of the title and insert "and amending RCW 43.101.220 and
29 43.101.350."

EFFECT: Statutory language is restored, such that the employment status of a person, whose employer does not provide the opportunity for training, is not impaired.

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
