2 (3) and insert "subject the petition to heightened scrutiny to verify
3 and canvass the names and signatures on the petition. The valid
4 signatures of all legal voters shall be counted, and no such signatures

6 signature of a petition signature gatherer."

7 On page 4, line 10, after "must" strike the remainder of subsection
8 (3)and insert "subject the petition to heightened scrutiny to verify
9 and canvass the names and signatures on the petition. The valid
10 signatures of all legal voters shall be counted, and no such signatures
11 shall be rejected solely on the basis that a filed petition lacks the
12 signature of a petition signature gatherer."

14 On page 5, line 28, after "must" strike the remainder of subsection
15 (3)and insert "subject the petition to heightened scrutiny to verify
16 and canvass the names and signatures on the petition. The valid
17 signatures of all legal voters shall be counted, and no such signatures
18 shall be rejected solely on the basis that a filed petition lacks the
19 signature of a petition signature gatherer."

EFFECT: Eliminates the requirement that the Secretary of State must refuse to file petitions for initiatives to the legislature, initiatives to the people, and referenda if the signature gatherer fails to complete the declaration. Requires that where such petitions do not have the signature of a petition-gatherer that the Secretary of State shall subject the signatures on the respective petitions to heightened scrutiny, accepting the otherwise valid signatures of legal voters.
