**Background:** The Washington Clean Air Act (RCW chapter 70.94), enacted in 1967 and amended several times, is the basis for state and local air pollution regulation.

**Summary of Bill:** Several non-substantive changes revise the Washington Clean Air Act to enhance readability, reduce redundancies, and eliminate obsolete provisions.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
