The legislature finds that environmental problems 9 10 in Puget Sound are complex and research is needed to provide 11 information that can guide protective and restorative actions, and to 12 explore and understand the impacts of a changing environment. legislature also finds that there is no predictable funding process for 13 14 Puget Sound research projects, including the aquatic rehabilitation The legislature declares that the state needs a process to 15 16 focus the scientific effort on the Puget Sound ecosystem and to

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 90.71 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) The action team or its successor agency shall:
 - (a) Identify gaps in science related to:
- 5 (i) The restoration of the aquatic rehabilitation zone one, created 6 in RCW 90.88.010;
 - (ii) Puget Sound environmental protection; and
- 8 (iii) Puget Sound environmental restoration;
- 9 (b) Formulate a research plan that narrows key science research 10 gaps identified in (a) of this subsection;
 - (c) Develop a competitive process for soliciting research on Puget Sound and on the aquatic rehabilitation zone one;
 - (d) Solicit and strategically prioritize research programs and projects in accordance with (b) and (c) of this subsection. Prioritization shall be determined by criteria that result in the greatest preservation or restoration progress;
 - (e) Select and fund the highest priority research programs and projects identified under (d) of this subsection; and
 - (f) Develop and implement an appropriate peer review process to review results from the research programs and projects selected and funded under (e) of this subsection.
 - (2) The Puget Sound scientific research account is created in the state treasury. All gifts, grants, federal moneys, or appropriations made to the account must be deposited into the account. Moneys in the account may be spent only after appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used only for research programs and projects for the purposes of subsection (1) of this section.
- 28 (3) The action team or its successor agency is subject to the open public meetings act, chapter 42.30 RCW.
