1 AN ACT Relating to private residential fire sprinklers; and
2 creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1)(a) The state building code council shall
5 form a technical advisory group to research and review policies and
6 procedures for residential fire sprinklers.

7 (b) The purpose of the study is the eventual development of a model
8 building code policy for residential fire sprinkler installation and
9 services.

10 (2) The technical advisory group must consist of:

11 (a) Representatives from: A city association, a county
12 association, the association of building officials, an association of
13 special purpose water-sewer districts, and a public utility district
14 association;

15 (b) A fire chief, a state licensed residential fire sprinkler
16 contractor, and an architect; and

17 (c) Any other representative deemed necessary to develop the model
18 policy.

1 (3) The state building code council shall report the findings of
2 the technical advisory group to the appropriate committees of the
3 legislature by January 15, 2008.
