1            AN ACT Relating to membership of the dental quality assurance  
2 commission; amending RCW 18.32.0351 and 18.32.0351; providing an  
3 effective date; and providing an expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.32.0351 and 1994 sp.s. c 9 s 204 are each amended  
6 to read as follows:

7            The Washington state dental quality assurance commission is  
8 established, consisting of (~~fourteen~~) eighteen members each appointed  
9 by the governor to a four-year term. No member may serve more than two  
10 consecutive full terms. In appointing the initial members of the  
11 commission, it is the intent of the legislature that, to the extent  
12 possible, members of the previous boards and committees regulating  
13 these professions be appointed to the commission. Members of the  
14 commission hold office until their successors are appointed. The  
15 governor may appoint members of the initial commission to staggered  
16 terms of from one to four years. Thereafter, all members shall be  
17 appointed to full four-year terms. (~~Twelve~~) Fifteen members of the  
18 commission must be dentists and (~~two~~) three members must be public  
19 members.

1       **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.32.0351 and 2007 c 269 s 16 are each amended to  
2 read as follows:

3       The Washington state dental quality assurance commission is  
4 established, consisting of (~~sixteen~~) twenty members each appointed by  
5 the governor to a four-year term. No member may serve more than two  
6 consecutive full terms. In appointing the initial members of the  
7 commission, it is the intent of the legislature that, to the extent  
8 possible, members of the previous boards and committees regulating  
9 these professions be appointed to the commission. Members of the  
10 commission hold office until their successors are appointed. The  
11 governor may appoint members of the initial commission to staggered  
12 terms of from one to four years. Thereafter, all members shall be  
13 appointed to full four-year terms. (~~Twelve~~) Fifteen members of the  
14 commission must be dentists, two members must be expanded function  
15 dental auxiliaries licensed under chapter 18.260 RCW, and (~~two~~) three  
16 members must be public members.

17       NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Section 1 of this act expires July 1, 2009.

18       NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Section 2 of this act takes effect July 1,  
19 2009.
