- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The department of licensing shall conduct a review of the need for regulation of general and specialty 7 contractors involved in the repair, alteration, or construction of 8 single-family homes using the public interest criteria set forth in RCW 9 18.118.010. In conducting the review, the department of licensing shall:
  - (a) Consult with representatives of and suppliers to residential contractors, consumer protection organizations, and any entity or individual that may assist in identifying the source or cause of prevalent home construction defects; and
  - (b) Examine any general and specialty contractor regulatory and licensing schemes in neighboring states.
- 17 (2) The department of labor and industries and the office of the 18 attorney general shall make available to the department of licensing 19 any home construction defect and related consumer complaints. The

department of licensing shall compile and evaluate consumer complaints and use this data to assist in conducting the review required by subsection (1) of this section.

- (3) By October 1, 2008, the department of licensing shall submit recommendations to the appropriate committees of the legislature regarding:
- (a) The need for regulation of general and specialty contractors involved in the construction and remodel of residential single-family homes; and
- 10 (b) If some form of regulation is recommended, the minimum 11 qualifications to meet the regulatory standard.
  - (4) This section expires July 1, 2009.
