1 AN ACT Relating to changing the number of district court judges;
2 and amending RCW 3.34.010.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 3.34.010 and 2005 c 91 s 1 are each amended to read as
5 follows:

6 The number of district judges to be elected in each county shall
7 be: Adams, two; Asotin, one; Benton, three; Chelan, two; Clallam, two;
8 Clark, six; Columbia, one; Cowlitz, (~~two~~) three; Douglas, one; Ferry,
9 one; Franklin, one; Garfield, one; Grant, two; Grays Harbor, two;
10 Island, one; Jefferson, one; King, twenty-one; Kitsap, four; Kittitas,
11 two; Klickitat, two; Lewis, two; Lincoln, one; Mason, one; Okanogan,
12 two; Pacific, two; Pend Oreille, one; Pierce, eleven; San Juan, one;
13 Skagit, two; Skamania, one; Snohomish, eight; Spokane, ten; Stevens,
14 one; Thurston, three; Wahkiakum, one; Walla Walla, two; Whatcom, two;
15 Whitman, one; Yakima, four. This number may be increased only as
16 provided in RCW 3.34.020.
