1 AN ACT Relating to donation of unclaimed personal property to
2 nonprofit charitable organizations; amending RCW 63.32.050 and
3 63.40.060; and adding a new section to chapter 63.35 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 63.32.050 and 1987 c 182 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 In addition to any other method of disposition of unclaimed
8 property provided under this chapter, the police authorities of a city
9 or town may donate unclaimed (~~bicyeles, trieyeles, and toys~~) personal
10 property to nonprofit charitable organizations (~~for use by~~). A
11 nonprofit charitable organization receiving personal property donated
12 under this section must use the property, or its proceeds, to benefit
13 needy persons.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 63.35 RCW
15 to read as follows:

16 In addition to any other method of disposition of unclaimed
17 property provided under this chapter, the state patrol may donate
18 unclaimed personal property to nonprofit charitable organizations. A

1 nonprofit charitable organization receiving personal property donated
2 under this section must use the property, or its proceeds, to benefit
3 needy persons.

4 **Sec. 3.** RCW 63.40.060 and 1987 c 182 s 2 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 In addition to any other method of disposition of unclaimed
7 property provided under this chapter, the county sheriff may donate
8 unclaimed (~~bicycles, tricycles, and toys~~) personal property to
9 nonprofit charitable organizations (~~for use by~~). A nonprofit
10 charitable organization receiving personal property donated under this
11 section must use the property, or its proceeds, to benefit needy
12 persons.
