- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The department of transportation shall
- 6 conduct a feasibility study to provide information on whether commuter
- 7 rail service between Everett and Index can be a meaningful component of
- 8 the region's future transportation system. The study must:
- 9 (a) Assess how many riders might be attracted to commuter rail service in this region;
- 11 (b) Identify and evaluate which locations along state route number
- 12 2 would most benefit from commuter rail service;
- 13 (c) Identify and evaluate potential station sites;
- 14 (d) Estimate costs for securing rights and constructing platforms 15 and stations;
- 16 (e) Provide a general analysis of the ability of the Everett to
- 17 Index rail section to accommodate commuter rail service, the effect of
- 18 this service on existing and planned rail freight operations, and an
- 19 estimate of how tourism in the region might be affected.

- 1 (2) The department shall deliver a report of this feasibility study 2 to the transportation committees of the house of representatives and 3 senate by February 1, 2008.
 - (3) This section expires December 31, 2008.
