3 is bedridden or is totally dependent on others for mobility." and  
4 insert ", in which case, an alternative type of monitoring shall be  
5 utilized."

8 **EFFECT:** Requires the Department of Corrections to use an  
9 alternative type of monitoring in circumstances where electronic  
10 monitoring of an offender placed on extraordinary medical placement  
11 would interfere with the function of the offender's medical equipment  
12 or would result in the loss of funding for the offender's medical  
13 care.
