11 On page 6, line 6, after "2008." strike "For purposes of this
12 section, green economy jobs include those in the primary industries
13 of a green economy including clean energy, green building, green
14 transportation, and environmental protection."

16 On page 11, line 7, after "(b)" insert "(i) "Green economy jobs"
17 includes jobs that are related to new technology developments in clean
18 energy, including industries involving agriculture, forestry, wind,
19 water, nuclear, solar, and biomass. These jobs include the
20 manufacturing and servicing of parts and facilities used specifically
21 in these industries.

22 (ii) "Green economy jobs" does not include: Government employees;
23 property, real estate, and community-association employees; social and
24 community service employees; accountants and auditors; appraisers and
25 assessors of real estate; personal financial advisors; loan officers;
26 computer support specialists; network computer systems administrators;
27 statisticians; surveyors; economists; market research analysts; urban

1 and regional planners; anthropologists and archaeologists; social
2 science research assistants; life, physical, and social science
3 technicians; social and human service assistants; lawyers; professors,
4 teachers, or instructors at educational institutions; library workers;
5 fine artists; interior designers; public relations specialists;
6 editors; writers; firefighting prevention workers unless employed by a
7 clean technology facility; janitors and cleaners; pest control
8 workers; nonfarm animal caretakers; tour guides and escorts; utility
9 meter readers; cement masons and concrete finishers; automotive body
10 and related repairers; automotive service technicians and mechanics;
11 bus and truck mechanics; mobile heavy equipment mechanics; mechanical
12 door repairers; air traffic controllers; drivers of any type of
13 fossil-fuel powered vehicle; traffic technicians; and cleaners of
14 vehicles and equipment.
