1 On page 8, line 8, after "system" insert "with membership as
2 provided in subsection (4) of this section"

4 On page 8, line 32, after "(4)" insert "(a) Except as provided in
5 subsection (b) of this subsection, the authority to impose or seek
6 voter approval of a vehicle fee as provided in subsections (1) and (3)
7 of this section is limited to those public transportation systems
8 governed by a body that includes a nonvoting individual recommended by
9 the labor organization representing the majority of the public
10 transportation employees within the public transportation system's
11 jurisdiction. The chair or cochairs of the governing body of the
12 public transportation system shall exclude the nonvoting member from
13 attending any executive session held for the purpose of discussing
14 negotiations with labor organizations. The chair or cochairs may
15 exclude the nonvoting member from attending any other executive
16 session.

17 (b) The requirement that a nonvoting member be appointed to the
18 governing body of a public transportation system does not apply to
19 public transportation systems that have no employees represented by a
20 labor union.

26 On page 8, line 24, after "system" insert "with membership as
27 provided in subsection (4) of this section"

EFFECT:

- Except for public transportation systems that do not have employees represented by a labor union, limits the authority to impose or seek voter approval of a vehicle fee to those public transportation systems that have a governing body member who is recommended by the labor organization representing the majority of the public transportation system's employees within the transportation system's jurisdiction.
- Requires the governing body of the public transportation system to exclude the nonvoting labor representative member from attending any portion of an executive session held for the purpose of discussing negotiations with labor organizations. Allows the chair or cochairs to exclude the nonvoting member from attending any other executive session.
