1 On page 2, after line 34 of the striking amendment, insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 2. RCW 41.76.035 and 2002 c 356 s 10 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,
6 provisions of collective bargaining agreements relating to
7 compensation shall not exceed the amount or percentage established by
8 the legislature in the appropriations act. If any compensation
9 provision is affected by subsequent modification of the appropriations
10 act by the legislature, both parties shall immediately enter into
11 collective bargaining for the sole purpose of arriving at a mutually
12 agreed upon replacement for the affected provision.

13 (2) An employer may provide additional compensation to faculty
14 that exceeds that provided by the legislature. Employers shall first
15 use tuition fees, as defined in chapter 28B.15.020 RCW, to provide
16 compensation to faculty prior to using revenue from any other source.
17 Only after tuition fees are expended may other sources be used."

EFFECT: Provides that baccalaureate institutions must use revenue from tuition first and expend it completely before using other sources of revenue to compensate faculty.
