1 On page 1, beginning on line 13 of the striking amendment, after  
2 "treasurer." strike all material through "penalty" on line 14 and  
3 insert "One hundred dollars of the assessment"

4  
5 On page 1, beginning on line 15 of the striking amendment, after  
6 "account." strike all material through "proportionally" on line 17 and  
7 insert "Any reduction in the penalty or fine and assessment imposed  
8 under section 6 of this act shall be applied proportionally between  
9 the penalty or fine and the assessment"

10  
11 On page 8, at the beginning of line 14 of the striking amendment,  
12 strike "~~((two))~~ four" and insert "two"

13  
14 On page 8, line 14 of the striking amendment, after "dollars."  
15 insert "In addition to any penalty or fine imposed under this  
16 subsection, two hundred dollars shall be assessed."

17  
18 On page 8, beginning on line 15 of the striking amendment, after  
19 "of" strike "~~((two))~~ four" and insert "two"

20  
21 On page 8, line 18 of the striking amendment, after  
22 "disabilities." insert "In addition to any penalty or fine imposed  
23 under this subsection, two hundred dollars shall be assessed."

25 On page 8, beginning on line 20 of the striking amendment, after  
26 "of" strike "~~((two))~~ four" and insert "two"

1 On page 8, line 25 of the striking amendment, after "46.16.385."  
2 insert "In addition to any penalty or fine imposed under this  
3 subsection, two hundred dollars shall be assessed."

4  
5 On page 9, beginning on line 1 of the striking amendment, strike  
6 all of subsection (10) and insert the following:

7 "(10) (~~The penalties~~) (a) The assessment imposed under  
8 subsections (7), (8), and (9) of this section shall be allocated as  
9 follows:

10 (i) One hundred dollars shall be deposited in the accessible  
11 communities account created in section 2 of this act; and

12 (ii) One hundred dollars shall be deposited in the multimodal  
13 account under RCW 47.66.070 for the sole purpose of supplementing a  
14 grant program for special needs transportation provided by transit  
15 agencies and nonprofit providers of transportation that is  
16 administered by the department of transportation.

17 (b) Any reduction in any penalty or fine and assessment imposed  
18 under subsections (7), (8), and (9) of this section shall be applied  
19 proportionally between the penalty or fine and the assessment. When a  
20 reduced penalty or fine and assessment are imposed, the amount  
21 deposited in the accounts identified in subsection (a) of this  
22 subsection shall be reduced equally and proportionally.

23 (c) The penalty or fine amounts shall be used by that local  
24 jurisdiction exclusively for law enforcement. The court may also  
25 impose an additional penalty sufficient to reimburse the local  
26 jurisdiction for any costs it may have incurred in removal and storage  
27 of the improperly parked vehicle."

**EFFECT:** (1) Changes the structure of the penalties imposed for parking infractions related to the unauthorized use of placards and license plates, blocking access aisles of parking spaces reserved for persons with disabilities, and unlawfully parking in a space reserved for a person with a physical disability. Instead

of a \$450 penalty, a \$250 penalty for the parking infraction plus a separate \$200 assessment will be imposed.

(1) The \$200 assessment, or any proportion imposed, will be divided between the Accessible Communities Account and the Multimodal Account.
