1 On page 23, after line 23, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 4. RCW 50.20.099 and 2000 c 2 s 10 are each amended to read
3 as follows:

4 (1) To ensure that unemployment insurance benefits are paid in
5 accordance with RCW 50.20.098, the employment security department shall
6 verify that an individual is eligible to work in the United States and
7 has a social security account number before the individual receives
8 ~~((training))~~ unemployment benefits under ~~((RCW 50.22.150))~~ this title.
9 The department may use the e-verify program administered by the United
10 States citizenship and immigration services for this purpose.

11 (2) By July 1, 2002, the employment security department shall:

12 (a) Develop and implement an effective method for determining,
13 where appropriate, eligibility to work in the United States for
14 individuals applying for unemployment benefits under this title;

15 (b) Review verification systems developed by federal agencies for
16 verifying a person's eligibility to receive unemployment benefits under
17 this title and evaluate the effectiveness of these systems for use in
18 this state; and

19 (c) Report its initial findings to the legislature by September 1,
20 2000, and its final report by July 1, 2002.

21 (3) Where federal law prohibits the conditioning of unemployment
22 benefits on a verification of an individual's status as a qualified or
23 authorized alien, the requirements of this section shall not apply."

24 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
25 internal references accordingly.

26 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Requires the Employment Security Department to verify

that an individual is eligible to work in the U.S. and has a Social Security account number before the individual receives unemployment benefits.
