1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 43.103.040 and 1995 c 398 s 5 are each amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 The council shall consist of (~~twelve~~) thirteen members who shall  
6 be selected as follows: One county coroner; one county prosecutor; one  
7 county prosecutor who also serves as ex officio county coroner; one  
8 county medical examiner; one county sheriff; one chief of police; the  
9 chief of the state patrol; two members of a county legislative  
10 authority; one pathologist who is currently in private practice;  
11 (~~and~~) two members of a city legislative authority; and one attorney  
12 whose practice of law includes significant experience representing  
13 clients charged with criminal offenses.

14 The governor shall appoint members to the council from among the  
15 nominees submitted for each position as follows: The Washington  
16 association of county officials shall submit two nominees each for the  
17 coroner position and the medical examiner position; the Washington  
18 state association of counties shall submit two nominees each for the  
19 two county legislative authority positions; the association of  
20 Washington cities shall submit two nominees each for the two city  
21 legislative authority positions; the Washington association of  
22 prosecuting attorneys shall submit two nominees each for the county  
23 prosecutor-ex officio county coroner and for the county prosecutor  
24 position; the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs  
25 shall submit two nominees each for the county sheriff position and the  
26 chief of police position; (~~and~~) the Washington association of  
27 pathologists shall submit two nominees for the private pathologist  
28 position; and the Washington association of criminal defense lawyers  
29 and the Washington defender association shall jointly submit two  
30 nominees for the criminal defense attorney position, one of whom must

1 actively manage or have significant experience in managing a public or  
2 private criminal defense agency or association, the other must have  
3 experience in cases involving DNA or other forensic evidence."
