

**ESHB 1114** - S COMM AMD

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 77.32.010 and 2008 c 329 s 923 are each amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a recreational  
6 license issued by the director is required to hunt for or take wild  
7 animals or wild birds, fish for, take, or harvest fish, shellfish, and  
8 seaweed. A recreational fishing or shellfish license is not required  
9 for carp, smelt, and crawfish, and a hunting license is not required  
10 for bullfrogs.

11 (2) A permit issued by the department is required to park a motor  
12 vehicle upon improved department access facilities.

13 (3) All hunters under the age of fourteen are required to be  
14 accompanied by a person age eighteen or older who has satisfied the  
15 requirement to complete a training course as provided in RCW 77.32.155,  
16 or who is not required by the terms of RCW 77.32.155 to complete a  
17 training course, when hunting for wild animals or wild birds. The  
18 accompanying adult hunter must stay within a physical range that  
19 permits continual unaided visual and auditory communication with the  
20 accompanied hunter. A youth hunter hunting on land owned by an  
21 immediate family member is exempt from this subsection. For the  
22 purposes of this subsection, "immediate family member" means a parent,  
23 grandparent, aunt, uncle, brother, or sister. A youth hunter engaged  
24 in falconry is exempt from this subsection.

25 (4) During the 2007-09 fiscal biennium to enable the implementation  
26 of the pilot project established in section 307, chapter 329, Laws of  
27 2008, a fishing permit issued to a nontribal member by the Colville  
28 Tribes shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
29 section on the waters of Lake Rufus Woods and on the north shore of

1 Lake Rufus Woods, and a Colville Tribes tribal member identification  
2 card shall satisfy the license requirements in subsection (1) of this  
3 section on all waters of Lake Rufus Woods.

4 **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.15.160 and 2000 c 107 s 237 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 A person is guilty of (~~an~~) a natural resources infraction, which  
7 shall be cited and punished as provided under chapter 7.84 RCW, if the  
8 person:

9 (1) Fails to immediately record a catch of fish or shellfish on a  
10 catch record card required by RCW 77.32.430, or required by rule of the  
11 commission under this title; (~~or~~)

12 (2) Fishes for personal use using barbed hooks in violation of any  
13 rule; (~~or~~)

14 (3) Engages in unaccompanied hunting in violation of the minimum  
15 age requirements established in RCW 77.32.010; or

16 (4) Violates any other rule of the commission or director that is  
17 designated by rule as an infraction.

18 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW  
19 to read as follows:

20 The department shall create and maintain a user-friendly web site  
21 that shows major recreation areas that are also used for hunting and  
22 the appropriate hunting seasons so that the public can access this  
23 information. The web site must include the recommendation that anyone  
24 recreating during hunting season may want to wear some form of  
25 fluorescent orange clothing, including a hat, vest, ribbon, or some  
26 other clothing that is fluorescent orange, in order to be more visible  
27 when recreating."
