

**ESHB 1906 - S AMD 9**

1 On page 5, line 7, after "April 5, 2009" insert ", provided that  
2 the rate of total unemployment, seasonally adjusted, as determined by  
3 the United States secretary of labor, continues to equal or exceed six  
4 percent. Claims with an effective date after the first Sunday  
5 following the first date on which the rate of total unemployment,  
6 seasonally adjusted, is less than six percent, are subject to RCW  
7 50.22.150, regardless of subsequent increases in the rate of total  
8 unemployment"

10 On page 8, line 29, after "April 5, 2009" insert ", and to claims with  
11 an effective date on or after the first Sunday following the first  
12 date on which the rate of total unemployment, seasonally adjusted, as  
13 determined by the United States secretary of labor is less than six  
14 percent, regardless of subsequent increases in the rate of total  
15 unemployment"

EFFECT: Provides that claims with an effective date on or after April 5, 2009, are subject to the new expanded provisions governing the training benefits program. However, when the unemployment rate drops below 6% the training benefits program reverts back to current law.
