

**ESHB 2035 - S AMD 397**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. 2008 c 230 s 4 (uncodified) is amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 (1) The sex offender policy board, as created by chapter . . .  
6 (Substitute Senate Bill No. 6596), Laws of 2008, shall review and make  
7 recommendations for changes to the statutory requirements relating to  
8 sex offender and kidnapping offender registration and notification.  
9 The review and recommendations shall include, but are not limited to:

10 (a) The appropriate class of felony and sentencing designations for  
11 a conviction of the failure to register;

12 (b) The appropriate groups and classes of adult offenders who  
13 should be required to register;

14 (c) The appropriate groups and classes of juvenile offenders who  
15 should be required to register;

16 (d) When a sex offender or kidnapping offender should be relieved  
17 of registration or notification requirements and the process for  
18 termination of those obligations; (~~and~~)

19 (e) Simplification of the statutory language to allow the  
20 department of corrections, law enforcement, and offenders to more  
21 easily identify registration and notification requirements; and

22 (f) The appropriate groups and classes of adult, and juvenile, if  
23 any, offenders who should be required to submit their electronic mail  
24 address or any other internet communication name or identity including,  
25 but not limited to, instant message, chat, or social networking names  
26 or identities, and the uniform resource locator of any personal web  
27 site created or operated by the person, for purposes of monitoring  
28 potentially inappropriate online behavior, and the appropriate  
29 sanctions for failure to provide such information in a timely and

1 accurate manner, as well as any other issues associated with  
2 establishing and implementing such a requirement.

3 (2) In formulating its recommendations, the board shall review the  
4 experience of other jurisdictions and any available evidence-based  
5 research to ensure that its recommendations have the maximum impact on  
6 public safety.

7 (3) The board shall report to the governor and the relevant  
8 committees of the legislature no later than November 1, 2009."
